

## 2011 Junior National Show Classifications and Show Order

**IMPORTANT for all Shows:** Each of the following classes **MAY** be broken into multiple classes to accommodate large numbers of entries, but separate classes **may NOT** be combined into one. For example, there **MAY** be four “Junior Heifer Calf” classes, but there **may NOT** be one single “Spring Yearling Females” class (combining Late and Early Spring females).

**B&O Female Classes** – Entry in this show binds the exhibitor to all regulations pertaining to Junior Nationals.

- Class 1. Junior Heifer Calves – calved between January 1 and February 28, 2011
- Class 2. Winter Heifer Calves – calved between November 1 and December 31, 2010
- Class 3. Senior Heifer Calves – calved between September 1 and October 31, 2010
- Class 4. **Division I Champion** – chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> place winners in Classes 1, 2, & 3
- Class 5. **Division I Res. Champion** – chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners in Classes 1, 2, & 3
- Class 6. Summer Yearling Females – calved between July 1 and August 31, 2010
- Class 7. Late Spring Yearling Females – calved between May 1 and June 30, 2010
- Class 8. **Division II Champion**– chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> place winners from Classes 6 & 7
- Class 9. **Division II Res. Champion**– chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners from Classes 6 & 7
- Class 10. Early Spring Yearling Females – calved between March 1 and April 30, 2010
- Class 11. **Division III Champion**– chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> place winners from Classes 10
- Class 12. **Division III Res. Champion**– chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners from Classes 10
- Class 13. Junior Yearling Females – calved between January 1 and February 29, 2010
- Class 14. Senior Yearling Females – calved between September 1 and December 31, 2009
- Class 15. **Division IV Champion** – chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> place winners in Classes 13 & 14
- Class 16. **Division IV Res. Champion**– chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners in Classes 13 & 14
- Class 17. **Grand Champion B&O Female** – chosen from Division Champions I, II, III, IV
- Class 18. **Reserve Grand Champion B&O Female** – chosen from Division Champion and Reserves I, II, III, IV
- Class 19. **Group of Two B&O Purebred Two Females** – **bred and owned** by the exhibitor

**Bred & Owned Bull Classes** – Entry in this show binds the exhibitor to all regulations pertaining to Junior Nationals.

- Class 1. Junior Bull Calves – calved between January 1 and February 28, 2011
  - Class 2. Winter Bull Calves – calved between November 1 and December 31, 2010
  - Class 3. Senior Bull Calves – calved between September 1 and October 31, 2010
  - Class 4. Summer Yearling Bulls – calved between July 1 and August 31, 2010
  - Class 5. Late Spring Yearling Bulls – calved between May 1 and June 30, 2010
  - Class 6. Early Spring Yearling Bulls – calved between March 1 and April 30, 2010
  - Class 7. Junior Yearling Bulls – calved between January 1 and February 29, 2010
  - Class 8. Senior Yearling Bull – calved between July 1 and December 31, 2009
  - Class 9. Two-Year-Old Bulls – calved between January 1 and June 30, 2009
  - Class 10. **Grand Champion B&O Bull** – chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> place winners in Classes 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, & 9
  - Class 11. **Reserve Grand Champion B&O Bull** – chosen from chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners in Classes 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, & 9
- (There are no divisions in the bulls show)

**Purebred Cow/Calf Pair Classes** – Entry in this show binds the exhibitor to all regulations pertaining to Junior Nationals.

Classes will be broke according to age of cow and determined based on number of entries after check-in is complete.

Class - **Grand Champion Purebred Cow/Calf Pair** – chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> place winners

Class - **Reserve Grand Champion Purebred Cow/Calf Pair** – chosen from chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners

**ShorthornPlus Cow/Calf Pair Classes** – Entry in this show binds the exhibitor to all regulations pertaining to Junior Nationals.

Classes will be broke according to age of cow and determined based on number of entries after check-in is complete.

Class - **Grand Champion ShorthornPlus Cow/Calf Pair** – chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> place winners

Class - **Reserve Grand Champion ShorthornPlus Cow/Calf Pair** – chosen from chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners

**Purebred Steer Classes** – Entry in this show binds the exhibitor to all regulations pertaining to Junior Nationals.

Class – Prospect Steers – steers weighing 900 lbs and less

Class - **Grand Champion Purebred Prospect Steer**– chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> place winners in Prospect steer classes

Class - **Reserve Grand Champion Purebred Prospect Steer** – chosen from chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners in Prospect steer classes

Class – Market Steers – steers weighing 901 lbs. and more

Class - **Grand Champion Purebred Market Steer**– chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> place winners in Market steer classes

Class - **Reserve Grand Champion Purebred Market Steer** – chosen from chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners in Market steer classes

Class - **Grand Champion Purebred Steer** – chosen from Champion Prospect and Market Steers

Class – **Reserve Grand Champion Purebred Steer** – chosen from Champion and Reserve Prospect and Market Steers

Class - **Grand Champion Bred & Owned Purebred Steer** – chosen from 1 placing B&O steers in each of the Prospect and Market classes – exhibitors will be notified in class by show official if qualified to participate. Steers will be marked in show program with a “Y” for yes or “N” for no for B&O.

Class – **Reserve Grand Champion Bred & Owned Purebred Steer** – chosen from 1 and 2 placing B&O steers in each of the Prospect and Market classes – exhibitors will be notified in class by show official if qualified to participate. Steers will be marked in show program with a “Y” for yes or “N” for no for B&O.

**ShorthornPlus Steer Classes** – Entry in this show binds the exhibitor to all regulations pertaining to Junior Nationals.

Classes will be broke according to weight and determined based on number of entries after check-in is complete.

Class - **Grand Champion ShorthornPlus Steer** – chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> place winners

Class - **Reserve Grand Champion ShorthornPlus Steer** – chosen from chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners

**(There is no Bred & Owned ShorthornPlus Steer selected)**

**ShorthornPlus Female Classes** – Entry in this show binds the exhibitor to all regulations pertaining to Junior Nationals.

Class 1. Junior Heifer Calves – calved between January 1 and February 28, 2011

Class 2. Winter Heifer Calves – calved between November 1 and December 31, 2010

Class 3. Senior Heifer Calves – calved between September 1 and October 31, 2010

Class 4. **Division I Champion** – chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> place winners in Classes 1, 2, & 3

Class 5. **Division I Res. Champion** – chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners in Classes 1, 2, & 3

Class 6. Summer Yearling Females – calved between July 1 and August 31, 2010

Class 7. Late Spring Yearling Females – calved between May 1 and June 30, 2010

Class 8. **Division II Champion**– chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> place winners from Classes 6 & 7

Class 9. **Division II Res. Champion**– chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners from Classes 6 & 7

Class 10. Early Spring Yearling Females – calved between March 1 and April 30, 2010

Class 11. **Division III Champion**– chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> place winners from Classes 10

Class 12. **Division III Res. Champion**– chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners from Classes 10

Class 13. Junior Yearling Females – calved between January 1 and February 29, 2010

Class 14. Senior Yearling Females – calved between September 1 and December 31, 2009

Class 15. **Division IV Champion** – chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> place winners in Classes 13 & 14

Class 16. **Division IV Res. Champion**– chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners in Classes 13 & 14

Class 17. **Grand Champion ShorthornPlus Female** – chosen from Division Champions I, II, III, IV

Class 18. **Reserve Grand Champion ShorthornPlus Female** – chosen from Division Champion and Reserves I, II, III, IV

Class 19. **Grand Champion Bred & Owned ShorthornPlus Female**– chosen from 1 placing B&O females in each of the ShorthornPlus div/classes – exhibitors will be notified in class by show official if qualified to participate. Females will be marked in show program with a “Y” for yes or “N” for no for B&O.

Class 20. **Reserve Grand Champion Bred & Owned ShorthornPlus Female** – chosen from 1 and 2 placing B&O females in each of the ShorthornPlus div/classes – exhibitors will be notified in class by show official if qualified to participate. Females will be marked in show program with a “Y” for yes or “N” for no for B&O.

**Owned Purebred Female Classes** – Entry in this show binds the exhibitor to all regulations pertaining to Junior Nationals and PACE shows

Class 1. Junior Heifer Calves – calved between January 1 and February 28, 2011

Class 2. **Division I Champion** – chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> place winners in Classes 1

Class 3. **Division I Res. Champion** - chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners in Classes 1

Class 4. Winter Heifer Calves – calved between November 1 and December 31, 2010

Class 5. Senior Heifer Calves – calved between September 1 and October 31, 2010

Class 6. **Division II Champion** – chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> place winners in Classes 4 & 5

Class 7. **Division II Res. Champion** – chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners in Classes 4 & 5

Class 8. Summer Yearling Females – calved between July 1 and August 31, 2010

Class 9. Late Spring Yearling Females – calved between May 1 and June 30, 2010

Class 10. **Division III Champion**– chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> place winners from Classes 8 & 9

Class 11. **Division III Reserve Champion**– chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners from Classes 8 & 9

Class 12. Early Spring Yearling Females – calved between April 1 and April 30, 2010

Class 13. **Division IV Champion**– chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> place winners from Class 12

Class 14. **Division IV Reserve Champion**– chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners from Class 12

Class 15. Early Spring Yearling Females – calved between March 1 and March 31, 2010

Class 16. **Division V Champion**– chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> place winners from Class 15

Class 17. **Division V Reserve Champion**– chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners from Class 15

- Class 18. Junior Yearling Females – calved between January 1 and February 29, 2010
- Class 19. **Division VI Champion**– chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> place winners from Class 18
- Class 20. **Division VI Reserve Champion**– chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners from Class 18
- Class 21. Senior Yearling Females – calved between September 1 and December 31, 2009
- Class 22. **Division VII Champion**– chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> place winners from Class 22
- Class 23. **Division VII Reserve Champion**– chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners from Class 22
- Class 24. **Grand Champion Purebred Owned Female** – chosen from champion divisions I, II, III, IV, V, VI, & VII
- Class 25. **Reserve Grand Champion Purebred Owned Female** – chosen from champion and reserve divisions I, II, III, IV, V, VI, & VII
- Class 26. **Champion Pair of Purebred Females** –owned by the exhibitor
- Class 27. **Best State Group of 4 Purebred Females**

**Senior/Junior Yearling Pregnancy Rule for exhibitors at all PACE shows:** Any senior/junior yearling female 28 months of age or older on or before the date of the PACE show must have a registered purebred natural calf at side and must be shown with calf. If purebred Senior/Junior Yearling has a ShorthornPlus calf at side, it is not eligible for the PACE Show, however it is eligible for the ShorthornPlus show if such show is available. All females 20 months of age on or before the date of the PACE show need to have a 60 day pregnancy verification signed by an accredited, non-owner veterinarian at the time the female is processed for the PACE show. Exhibitors may be asked to present said verification upon the request of the Show officials or ASA representatives. If verification cannot be produced, the female may be allowed to participate if the exhibitor can produce a qualified veterinarian to examine the female at the show site, and verify a 60-day pregnancy. Any infractions against this rule will lead to disqualification of that animal for that specific PACE show.
